WHO BENEFITS?

Run by volunteers for the village and as a charity fundraiser, the fete is held under the auspices of Sherfield Village Hall in association with St. Leonard's Parish Church. Any resident can join the committee and village groups can raise funds on the day or apply for a percentage of the proceeds. This year, in challenging times, we have also chosen to support Basingstoke Foodbank.

Basingstoke Foodbank

Public donations make up 90% of the food distributed by *Trussell Trust foodbanks*.1 in 5 people in the UK lives below the poverty line.



Basingstoke Foodbank

has fed over 42,000 people since opening ten years ago. We offer 3-4 days' worth of food 'n toiletries to people in crisis, while aiming to link them with local agencies which could help relieve the root causes of their crisis: (teams from school & college family support, social housing tenancy support, CAP Debt, Mental Health agencies, Social Services, Domestic Abuse.) They assess people's situations, can issue Foodbank vouchers and offer support. Citizens' Advice Drop-in's, in all our centres, help to make the support more accessible.

Our 'Church family' has been caring for the community for over 900 years and is still very active! We serve and care for the people of Sherfield





Blue Badge holders only will be given entry to the Bramley Road car park RG27 oBU (except for access).




